High School Equivalency (HSE)

CCC's HSE program offers multilevel, interdisciplinary classes to assist students in developing their basic academic skills in preparation for taking an HSE exam such as the GED® or HiSet®, enrolling in college, or entering the workforce.

English as a Second Language (ESL)

CCC's ESL program offers levelled classes to assist students in improving their English reading, writing, and speaking skills in preparation for taking an English-speaking HSE class, enrolling in college, or entering the workforce.
