What to expect at the Test Center

The National Test Center at Cannon Air Force Base provides test services for CLEP and DSST. Proctoring services for universities or institutions are available upon request.

When taking an exam at NTC, always bring two forms of ID: military ID and a secondary ID with your picture, name and official signature. Arrive on time for your-scheduled test time, and secure all personal belongings in your vehicle before entering the test center. Please allow two hours to take your exam. The CLEP and DSST exams are timed, any breaks, unless otherwise scheduled, run the timer. For special accommodations, please contact the center before your test day.

Any scratch paper, pencils, or calculators, etc. will be provided by the test center in accordance with the exam policy.

ITEMS NOT ALLOWED:

- Cell phones or any electronics including watches, cassette recorders, personal electronic devices, or any instrument that can transmit, receive, or preserve, in any fashion, audio or video data.
- Calculators
- Notes, books, or other study materials
- Food / Drinks
- Backpacks, handbags, pocketbooks, etc.

Security is very important in the center. Any violation will render you ineligible for testing. The center is under strict monitoring and does not allow talking or other distractions.

Candidates must now register online for CLEP exams

- I. Find your college's CLEP policy on accepting exams.
- 2. Create an account at clep.collegeboard.org
- 3. Follow the instructions and register for your CLEP exam. Active Duty must mark themselves as DANTES funded & not a Veteran.
- 4. At the end, choose your school for CLEP to send the results to. For CCAF, you must type out Community College of the Air Force.
- 5. Please **PRINT** the registration receipt with your Ticket ID# and bring it with you to your exam.
- 6. CLEP now gives Active Duty airmen a free study guide, this will be in your account.

Periodically there are issues with registering on a government computer, you may have to use a smartphone or personal computer to register.
