CCC's HSE program offers multilevel, interdisciplinary classes to assist students in developing their basic academic skills in preparation for taking an HSE exam, such as the GED® or HiSet®, enrolling in college, or entering the workforce.

English as a Second Language (ESL)

CCC's ESL program offers leveled classes to assist students in improving their English reading, writing, and speaking skills in preparation for taking an English-speaking HSE class, enrolling in college, or entering the workforce.

Total Literacy Clovis (TLC) is a new program that offers adults in Clovis and the surrounding area free tutoring services in literacy, basic math, and computer skills.

The ENLACE Program at CCC partners with area K-12 schools to provide educational outreach and support services to generally underserved and underrepresented students and families in Clovis, Portales, and the surrounding rural areas with the goal of increasing high school graduation and college enrollment rates among served populations.
